We are pleased to announce that the matters outlined below were reported and resolved at the 103rd Annual General Meeting of Shareholders of Terumo Corporation held today.

- Matters reported:**
1. Business Report, Consolidated Financial Statements, and Audit Report concerning Consolidated Financial Statements by the Accounting Auditor and the Audit/Supervisory Committee for the 103rd Term (from April 1, 2017, to March 31, 2018)
The contents of the above Business Report, Consolidated Financial Statements and Audit Report concerning Consolidated Financial Statements were reported.
 2. Non-consolidated Financial Statements for the 103rd Term (from April 1, 2017, to March 31, 2018)
The contents of the above Non-consolidated Financial Statements were reported.

Matters resolved:

- Proposal 1:** Appropriation of Surplus
The proposal was approved and adopted as proposed. The year-end dividend for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2018 was determined to be 27 yen per share (together with the interim dividend of 23 yen, the annual dividends amounts to 50 yen per share).
- Proposal 2:** Election of 8 Directors (Excluding Directors Who Serve as Audit/Supervisory Committee Members)
The proposal was approved and adopted as proposed. Eight persons, namely, Mr. Takayoshi Mimura, Mr. Shinjiro Sato, Mr. Toshiaki Takagi, Mr. Shoji Hatano, Mr. David Perez, Mr. Ikuo Mori, and Dr. Ryuzo Ueda were re-elected as directors and Ms. Yukiko Kuroda were newly elected as a director (excluding directors who serve as Audit/Supervisory Committee Members) and assumed their respective offices. Three persons, namely, Mr. Ikuo Mori, Dr. Ryuzo Ueda and Ms. Yukiko Kuroda are independent directors.
- Proposal 3:** Election of 1 Substitute Director Who Serves as an Audit/Supervisory Committee Member
The proposal was approved and adopted as proposed. Mr. Koichi Sakaguchi was elected as substitute director who serves as an Audit/Supervisory Committee Member.
